- (d) to conduct sanctioned matches, specialty shows, obedience trials, tracking tests, agility trials, herding trials and other events under the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club where applicable;
- (e) to promote responsible and ethical breeding practices through a Code of Ethics that will protect the breed's unique and desired traits, dependability and health;
- (f) to provide a forum for fellowship, mutual cooperation and development of friendships among owners and fanciers of the Berger Picard breed;
- (g) to promote the Picard and educate persons interested in the breed.
